What is FrogWatch USA?

FrogWatch USA is a long-term volunteer monitoring program educating volunteers on how to get involved in their community to collect and report information about frog and toad populations in the United States. Volunteers register a wetland and record the frog and toad species and calling intensities observed throughout the breeding season (February through August). Through FrogWatch USA, participants learn and practice science and establish a closer relationship with the natural environment.
