COURSE TUITION FEE

AIRFARE / NEAREST AIRPORT

Orlando International Airport (MCO) is the closest airport

LODGING AT THE RADISSON WORLDGATE RESORT

The rate is \$89 per night for a single or double room. Price does not include 6% Florida state sales tax. Due to limited hotel space, the exact hotel information will only be given out to those accepted into the course. The hotel is in Kissimmee, Florida, approximately 10 minutes from the classroom at Disney's Animal Kingdom.

FOOD COSTS

Travel meals \$20-\$40 per day depending on distance and method of travel.

Breakfast \$10-\$20/day options range from quick service to sit down buffet.

Lunch is brought in daily for approximately \$10/day

Dinner \$6-\$30/day several restaurants are within walking distance to the hotel, varying from fast food to sit-down.
